### Behaviour Philosophy

We have a culture of excellent behaviour in school and it is a team effort to maintain this and uphold high standards.



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Our 3 school rules Be Ready, Be Kind and Be Safe which apply to everybody and should be regularly reinforced in conversations by everybody. We have high expectations of behaviour for all adults and children and encourage Fantastic Walking around school.

In a nutshell, our behaviour philosophy stems from a child centred approach where we are continually developing good behaviour. We focus on consistency, good routines, positive role models and strategies, understanding and empathy and an individualised approach which comes from knowing our children and families really well and also them knowing us well. Building relationships is key.



We encourage our children to make the right choice and explain this using red and green choices. We trust our staff to use their professional judgement with regard to sanctions and support can be found from each other and the Headteacher. We focus on quality CPD to upskill and support our staff with a focus on SEND and behaviour.

Any behaviour that is reported to a parent must be logged onto CPOMS (our safeguarding system)
